

# Setting the Stage



## Why take part in this workshop?

During this 2 day workshop educators will design learning opportunities for Australian school children (learners) that promote and develop positive attitudes and perceptions and habits of mind. This is an action learning workshop where participants work through a learning partnership to focus on teacher practice. Learning design theory will be put into practice using research based pedagogy.

The central role of the teacher in making a difference to learning will be explored and elaborated. Educators involved in this 2 day workshop will co - construct knowledge in the context of building learner capacity to achieve. Community partnership solutions that focus on prevention and early intervention, the learner at the centre, will be specific to each participant/team's own learning site context and their subsequent project conceptualisation and development throughout the workshop.

## This ANSN 2 day workshop Setting the Stage is about.....

### Content *declarative knowledge* (head: thinking)

Identifying the disconnect for learners that occurs between life needs and school tasks. Why aren't the two worlds complimentary?

### Process *procedural knowledge* (hand: willing)

building a repertoire of strategies and resources that focus on good pedagogy in learning design. Participants will facilitate learning journeys that access equitable opportunities for success. The intent here is to align curriculum, pedagogy and assessment through new thinking about learning, teaching and school reform encompassing 5 core areas:

self awareness; social awareness; self management; responsible decision making; relationship skills

### People *conditional knowledge* (heart: feeling)

learning from each other about how to do things differently; filling the social and behavioural gaps for learners. We only ever complement one another when we know where we are all coming from.
